### **Attendance, Participation and Behavior Policy**

Girls Inc.'s middle school programs are open to all girls. We expect that girls who enroll will attend regularly, participate and follow the rules of the program. Parents must notify the program by 12:30 if their daughter is going to be absent. Failure to notify the program may result in termination from the program and or removal from the transportation list.

Attendance is important in developing relationships with the other girls, the staff, building a sense of belonging and understanding of the program's culture. Attendance is also important because of the projects the girls work on in their programs. Missing a day can throw off a girl's progress and if she is working in group, it affects the group's progress. Maintaining good attendance demonstrates each girl's ability to uphold her commitments and demonstrates her ability to be responsible. Girls who do not maintain regular attendance will not be able to participate in field trips and special events.

Participation from each girl is expected. The middle school programs offer many familiar activities to the girls as well as new activities to help the girls learn new things and take healthy risks. Girls who participate have a better experience and gain more from each activity. Girls who decide not to participate are usually bored and end up misbehaving. If a girl chooses not to participate regularly, a behavior notice will be sent home.

Behavior requirements for the Odyssey program are based on five simple rules:

- 1. Treat Yourself, Others and Property with Respect
- 2. Follow Directions
- 3. Actively Participate
- 4. Leave Negative Behavior at the Door
- 5. Practice Safety

Staff will talk with a girl if she is not following a rule. If the issue is resolved no further action will be taken. If, after being a reminded a girl continues to break the rules her parent/guardian will notified either in writing or by telephone depending on the severity of the incident. If a girl can not follow the rules after her parents were notified she may be asked to take time off from the program.

Any act of physical or verbal violence including hitting, pushing, throwing something, swearing, and threats or other extremely negative talk may result in immediate suspension or termination from the program.

#### **Internet Use Policy**

#### **Availability of Internet Access**

Girls Incorporated offers access to the Internet (an international, unregulated computer network which provides digital pathways to information sites) during our after school programs and summer programs. Girls Inc. members typically may access the Internet during activity periods as well as during unstructured time at the beginning and end of the program day.

#### **Disclaimer Notice**

During computer access times, Girls Inc. staff and/or volunteers are on hand to help with girls' questions and generally oversee computer use. However, the girls operate the individual workstations themselves, and ultimately Girls Inc. has no control over the availability of websites, which sites will post, or the content of information-text or images —that is retrieved from the Internet. This information could contain content that Girls Inc., the child or parent may consider objectionable or inappropriate for the child to be viewing.

Girls and their parents should be aware that the Internet may contain inaccurate and incomplete information, and that the Internet may contain information that may not be suitable for children, such as controversial or sexually explicit material that some may find offensive or inappropriate.

Members are responsible and accountable for following all rules and policies when using Girls Inc. computers or their personal computer. It should also be noted that Girls Inc. staff or designated volunteer instructors may review files and communications to ensure that members are using network and equipment properly. Member and parents should not expect that information stored or displayed on Girls Inc. machines will be private.

Girls Inc. will not provide e-mail accounts or access to members unless part of a specific program. Members who have personal e-mail accounts from another source may access those from Girls Inc. computers only with prior parent/guardian permission.

#### **Internet Safety Instruction**

Girls Inc. will offer introductory instruction for all members on appropriate use of the Internet and related safety practices. The introduction will cover Girls Inc. policies as well as offer examples of use and age-appropriate online resources for the girls to consider accessing.

Parents are strongly encouraged to stay in touch with their child's online activities—discuss what is being seen or done online and, when possible, explore the web together.

#### **Required Permission Forms**

In order for a member to access the Internet while at Girls Inc., she will have to sign the User Agreement Form, indicating that she agrees to Girls Inc.'s Internet Use Policy rules and regulations. She must also have signed permission from her parent/guardian.

#### **Internet Rules and Regulations**

Before accessing the Internet, users must agree to the Girls Inc. Internet Use Policy, sign the User Agreement, and have a parent/guardian sign the Internet Parent Permission Form.

Members may directly access the Internet. Girls Inc. staff will encourage members to access educational/age-appropriate sites, but they have no control over what sites post. Children might read or see offensive material. By signing the Parent Permission Form, parents assume responsibility for their children's Internet use

The following uses of Girls Inc. computers and Internet access are prohibited:

- Accessing or transmitting any material which is deemed unlawful, obscene, sexually explicit, or otherwise inappropriate for children.
- Using the Internet in any other illegal manner (harassing others, hacking, releasing viruses, etc.)
- Altering or damaging Girls Inc. software, hardware or data
- Unauthorized software installation
- Accessing (or attempting to access) unauthorized files, passwords, etc.
- Copyright infringement
- Providing Internet access to unauthorized user
- Unauthorized downloading or copying of information or software
- Using the Internet in ways not authorized by parent/guardian
- Not complying with instructions given by Girls Inc. staff/volunteers

#### **Violations of Policy**

Any violations of Girls Inc.'s rules and policies regarding Internet use, as well as other programs rules, and applicable government laws shall be reviewed individually by case. Any violations of these rules and policies may result in the loss of Internet and possibly computer privileges, and termination from Girls Inc. programming if there are multiple infractions.
